The CSOC Program Administrator will assist the Program Coordination Group to oversee program implementation, make training and provider recommendations, measure the program's progress, and assist in resolving ongoing challenges to program efficiency. The program's cost will be paid directly to CSOC from the participating agencies JBBS funds.

- Developing a Work Plan that supports the JBBS Coordination Group
- Participate in JBBS Quarterly Meetings
- Oversee the operations of the JBBS program with the agency.
- Assist in the development of a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) and contracts for service providers (subcontractors)
- Communicate any program changes to the assigned JBBS Program Manager, including staffing changes.
- Ensure invoices are submitted appropriately and on time, monthly, as outlined in the contract.
- Submit to BHA, as requested, any or all the following prevalence data: critical incidents, demographics, information, numbers of clients served, types and quantities of services delivered, number and percentages who successfully transitioned to community-based services, and program discharge outcomes.
- Regular site visits to participating agencies to ensure proper management of the program.
- Coordinate and provide services to JBBS participants as they transition out of the jail.
- Provide educational opportunities to JBBS participants.
