A 2-week intensive career development symposium for Command-level Law Enforcement personnel designed to enhance leadership and management skills.

The [Command Staff Institute](#) is a collaborative environment in which participants will:

- Recall, evaluate, and apply the most current ideas in relevant leadership theory
- Evaluate and apply select management tools to command-staff level activities
- Remember, understand, apply, and evaluate the ethics of command
- Analyze and evaluate best practices in American policing; apply broader policing trends to Agency/Department-specific contexts
- Apply all course concepts to an in-class group project that either (1) analyzes a hypothetical agency and makes comprehensive recommendations to solve the identified problems or (2) an appropriate historical vignette/scenario.

Candidates for the Institute must hold or be promotable to the rank of Lieutenant or higher, be recognized in their agency as an effective supervisor, and be nominated by their Chief or Sheriff. A letter/email of approval from the attendee's Chief of Sheriff must be submitted within 5 days of registration.

Class starts at 8:00 am daily
